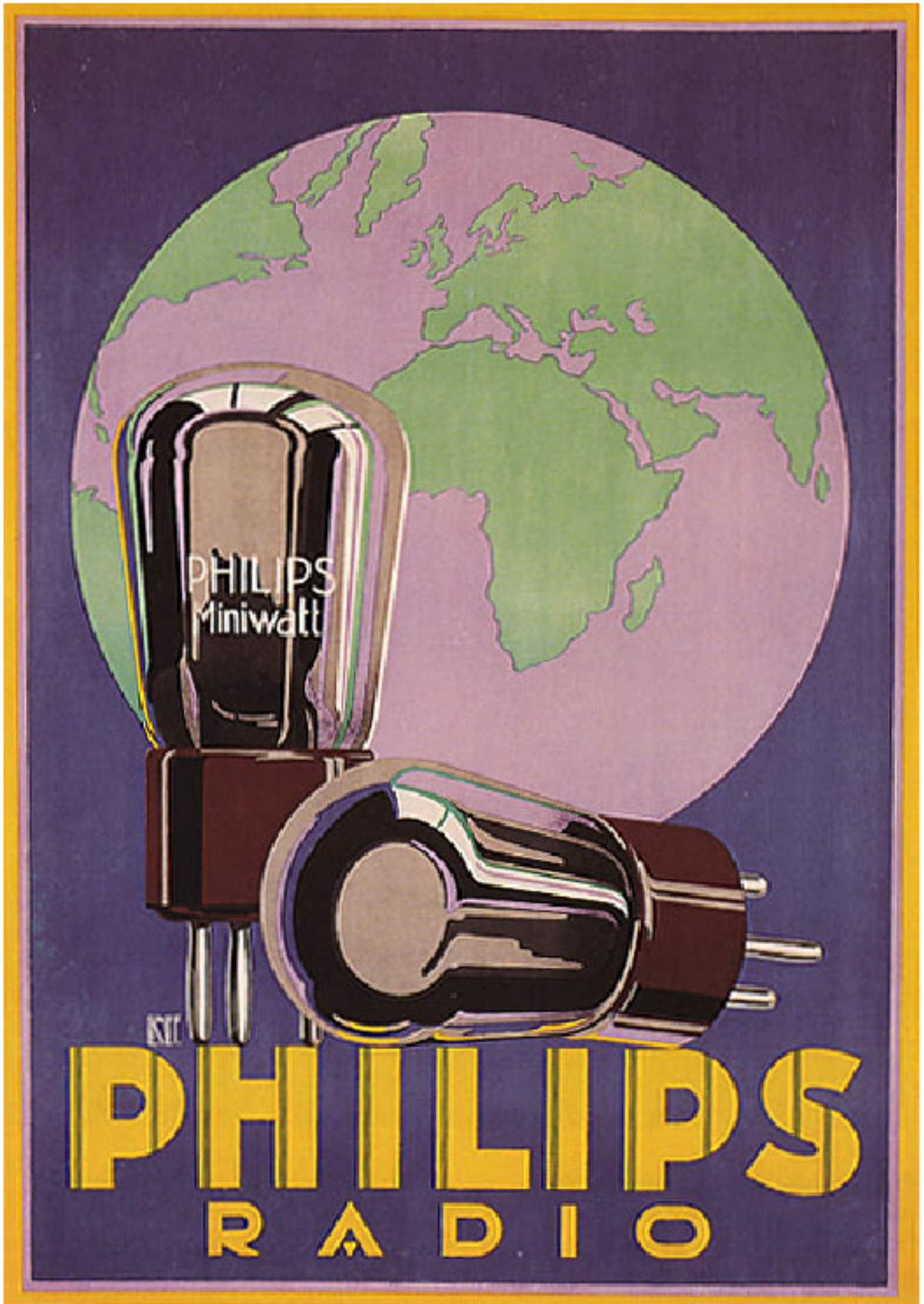
### ELECTION NOTICE
