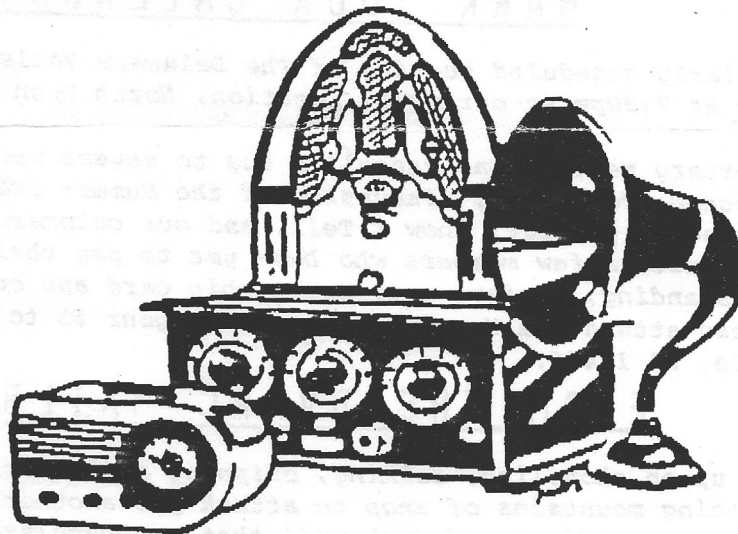
BITS AND PIECES
